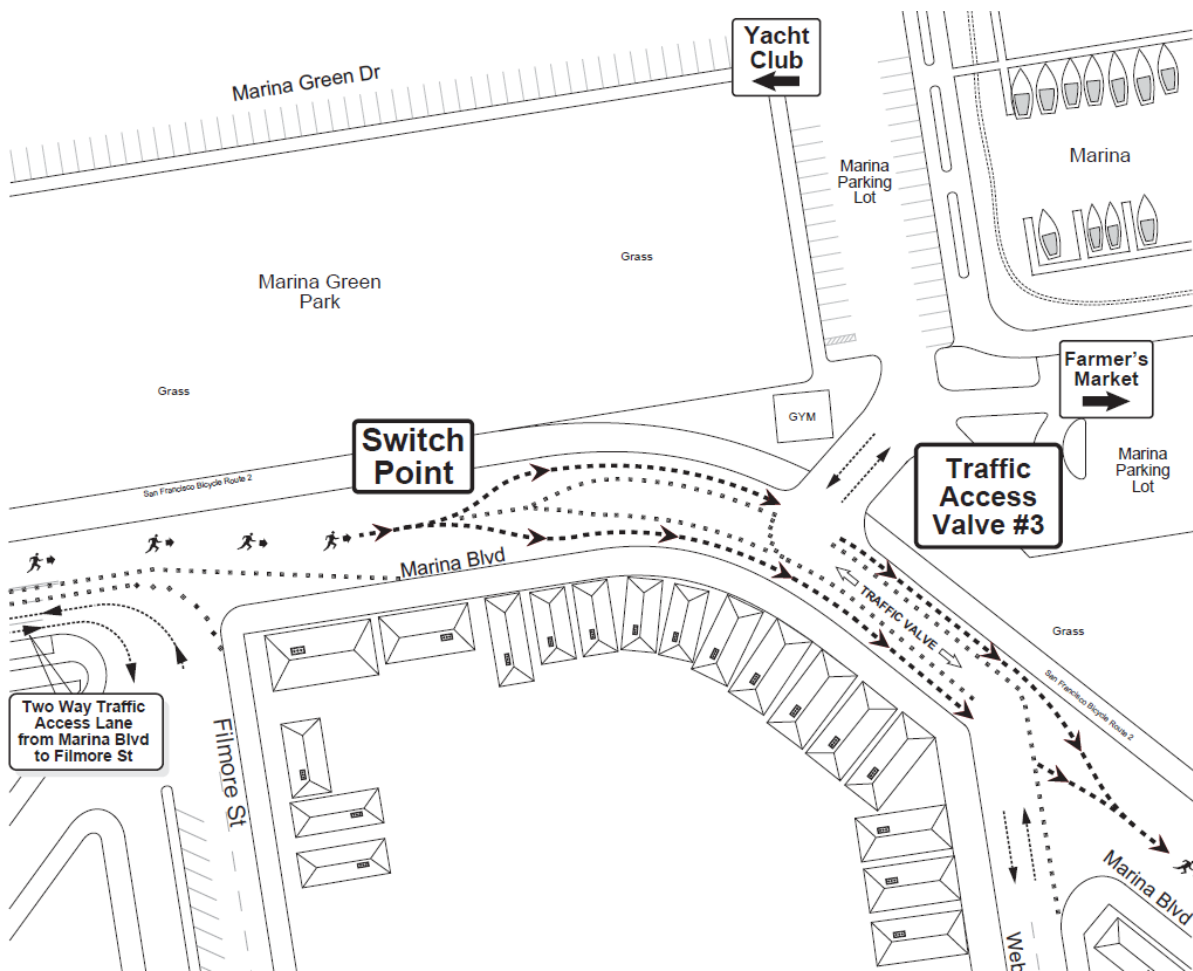

Fort Mason, Marina Green, Harbormaster's Office, and Marina Berths Access Via Webster Street Valve

Webster Traffic Valve – Access to Fort Mason piers and lower buildings, farmers' market, marina & yacht clubs

- Valve starts at Webster St & Marina Blvd beginning at 7:45 AM after the last outbound runner has safely gotten to the Fillmore Street intersection
- Every 90 seconds, the traffic crew will transition runners back and forth around vehicles allowing them to cross runners
- Traffic Crew assisted by Volunteers will compress the runners so they stay on the north side of Marina Blvd
- Officer on Fillmore & Marina Blvd will allow vehicles into valve in the middle of Marina Blvd
- Volunteers will then transition the runners around the vehicles to the south side of the street thereby allowing the vehicles to turn left into Fort Mason and continue into the farmers' market, marina & yacht clubs
- Reversing the process will allow vehicles out of Fort Mason
- Police and Traffic Control will work together to determine necessary staffing to safely execute the Webster Valve



Yacht Club Access via Baker St to Yacht Rd

Access to the Yacht clubs will be impacted from 6:15am-11:00am on race day, with VERY limited access between 6:10am-7:55am. Vehicles needing access to the Yacht clubs during this time must follow the directions listed below.

- Access to the Yacht clubs will be provided by a controlled crossing. Vehicles must approach on Baker Street where SFPD will assist them crossing the runners at the Yacht Rd intersection.
- There will be no access to the Yacht clubs via Scott St or Buchanan St entrances.
