RACE DAY

The Start Village for the Marathon & 1/2 Marathon is located behind Planet Hollywood on the corner of Harmon Ave. and Audrie Lane. You will be able to access the Start Village from the northeast off Flamingo and from the southwest off Harmon and Audrie.

The finish line is located on Las Vegas Blvd at The Mirage with the participants exiting at Flamingo Rd.

All participants **MUST** go directly to the Start Village pre-race. The start line is **ONLY** accessible from the Start Village and cannot be directly accessed. You will be led to the Start Line by race officials.

Las Vegas Monorail

The Las Vegas Monorail is a convenient option for getting to the Marathon & 1/2 Marathon start line festival and is offering participants and spectators exclusive fare discounts race week. Your destination for arrival at the Marathon & 1/2 Marathon start line festival is the **Bally's/Paris Station**, which is a very short walk to the Festival (**see map below**).

The Las Vegas Monorail is excited to offer Mobile Ticketing to get you there even quicker! Once you arrive in Las Vegas, locate your Monorail ticket on your mobile device. Scan the QR code directly at any fare gate located at one of our seven stations. No need for paper tickets, confirmations or redemption codes, just Scan and Go!

The Start Village and Finish lines are both within walking distance to many area hotels. Many of the surrounding intersections have pedestrian bridges that should be used to cross the street. Routes to get to the Start Village from various areas are noted in the map below.

Parking

Participant parking is available at Strip hotels near the start and finish. Parking fees will be charged at various locations, please visit <https://www.vegas.com/transportation/parking-garages/> for additional information regarding parking options and fees. To be closer to your car after you finish, you can park at any hotels near the finish and take the Monorail to the Bally's/Paris Station to get to the Start Village. It is advised to avoid parking at hotels on the West Side of the strip, including New York New York, Aria, Park MGM and Excalibur due to the Vegas Golden Knights hockey game which is concurrent with the marathon.

Runner Drop Off – SEE MAP BELOW

There will be a designated runner drop-off on E Harmon Ave on Kishner Dr. (between Koval Ln. and Lamar Cir). Participants will walk west on E Harmon Ave to Audrie Lane to access the Start Village.

Waze

Waze is an interactive traffic and navigation app that will incorporate road closures for the race. Participants and spectators can download the app for free to their smartphone to avoid road closures when navigating the roads and areas affected race weekend. Download here.
