

Access to Popular Destinations

The Craft Fair, Community Flea Market, many shops and dining establishments in the **French Market** are open on Sunday at 7 am. Northbound/Lake bound N Peters Street/Decatur Street will be closed between Poydras St. and Esplanade Ave. from 6:15 am to 11:15 am. There will be an access lane on riverbound Decatur to from St. Phillip St. to Dumaine St to allow vehicles to get into the French Quarter.

The **National World War II Museum** is open on Sunday from 9 am – 5 pm. On race day, expect road closures on the streets surrounding the museum including Magazine St until 10:30 am. At that time, the marathon and half marathon will have both cleared the area and guests will be able to access the WWII Museum parking lots.

The **Shops at Canal Place** are open on Sunday's 12 noon – 7 pm. and traffic routes on Canal Street at N. Peters near this mall will reopen by 11:15 am.

The **Children's Museum** is open from 12 noon – 4:30 pm on Sundays. Magazine Street will be cleared by 10:30 am.

St. Louis Cemetery #3, located on Esplanade Ave., will not be accessible on race day through the front entrance until after 12 Noon.

The **Shops at Jax Brewery** is open daily 10 am – 7 pm and Decatur Street will reopen to vehicle traffic at 11:15 am.

Audubon Zoo is open 10 am – 5 pm and visitors will be able to access the Zoo from Broadway. Another alternative is to exit S. Carrollton from I-10 and continue south bound until Leake Ave. Head east on Leake Ave. to the public parking lot for the Zoo.

Aquarium of the Americas & IMAX Theatre will be open 10 am – 5 pm. Canal Street at N. Peters Street will be reopen to vehicular traffic at 11:15 am to access discounted parking lots.

The **Audubon Insectarium** is open on Sundays from 10 am – 5 pm and traffic on Canal Street west of N. Peters will reopen by 11:15 am.

The **Audubon Park Golf Course** is open on Sunday beginning at 7 am. Visitors will be able to access the Golf Course from the west side of Audubon Park. Head river bound on Broadway to southbound on Leake Ave., to eastbound on Magazine to access the entrance on Golf Club Drive. Another alternative is to exit S. Carrollton from I-10 and continue south bound until Leake Ave., to eastbound on Magazine to access the entrance on Golf Club Drive.

The **Outlet Collection at Riverwalk** is open 10 a.m. to 7 pm on Sundays and traffic on Poydras Street at Convention Center Blvd will be allowed after 10:30 am, and traffic on Canal St. at St. Peters after 11:15 am.

Mardi Gras World is located near the start mile 9 of the race course and is open daily from 9:30 am – 4:30 pm. Magazine Street will reopen by 10:30 am on Sunday. To access Mardi Gras World before 10:30 am, it is recommended to use the CCC. From the CCC eastbound, exit at Tchoupitoulas Street and turn right on Tchoupitoulas, turn left on Henderson to access Mardi Gras World. To access from the CCC

westbound, exit Tchoupitoulas Street, turn right on Tchoupitoulas St, turn left on Henderson to access Mardi Gras World.

The **New Orleans Museum of Art** is open on Sundays from 10 am – 5pm. Northbound LeLong Drive will be closed from 7:00 am to 12:45 pm to host the final miles of the race. Southbound LeLong Drive will be closed from 7:00 am to 3:00 pm. Access from Carrollton and Esplanade Avenues will be available after 12 noon.

Morial Convention Center

To access the Morial Convention Center between 6:00 and 10:30 am from the CCC eastbound and exit at Tchoupitoulas Street, turn left on Annunciation Street, right on Andrew Higgins Street and left on Convention Center Blvd to access parking. To access from the CCC westbound, exit Tchoupitoulas Street, turn left on Tchoupitoulas Street at the bottom of the ramp, turn right on Andrew Higgins then left on Convention Center Blvd to access parking.

Touro Infirmary Hospital

To access the Touro Infirmary Hospital between 6:00 and 10:00 am, approach eastbound (downtown) on Magazine Street. Turn north (lakebound) on Antonine then east (downtown) on Prytania St. to access parking and the hospital.

Children's Hospital

From 6:15 to 10:45 am use the following routes to access Children's Hospital.

- From uptown; head east (downtown) on Magazine Street. Turn right (riverbound) on Henry Clay.
- Leaving the Hospital to go uptown: go west on Tchoupitoulas Street, turn right on East Drive and left on Magazine Street.
- Access to and from downtown is not affected.
